Common Medical Prefixes

Prefix	Meaning	Example
a-, an-	without	anemia (without blood)
brady-	slow	bradycardia (slow heart)
dys-	difficult, painful	dyspnea (difficult breathing)
hyper-	above, excessive	hypertension (high blood pressure)
hypo-	below, deficient	hypoglycemia (low blood sugar)
poly-	many	polyuria (excessive urination)
tachy-	fast	tachycardia (fast heart rate)

-ectomy -itis -ology -osis -plasty -scopy	surgical removal inflammation study of condition surgical repair visual examination	appendectomy arthritis cardiology stenosis rhinoplasty colonoscopy
